He then moved to Rock Hill, South Carolina in 1997 where he practiced the full breadth of general surgery for ten years. While there, he introduced a variety of minimally invasive procedures to the community, including laparoscopic colon resection, laparoscopic gastric bypass, and laparoscopic hernia repairs, as well as sentinel lymph node biopsy for breast and skin cancers. In addition, he served as Chairman of the Department of Surgery, as the Medical Director of the Surgical Weight Loss Program, and as a member of the hospital's Board of Directors.

Dr. Thies is Board Certified by the American Board of Surgery and is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons.

His special interests include minimally invasive surgery, cancer surgery, surgical critical care and nutrition. He provides the full range of general surgical care, including treatment of which includes laparoscopic approaches where appropriate in:

Dr. Thies has been practicing in Charlotte since 2007. He serves as a Trauma Surgeon for Presbyterian Hospital and operates in both the CMC and Presbyterian hospital systems.
